Imagine you are an Ancient Egyptian living in a small village along the Nile River. Describe your daily activities and responsibilities:

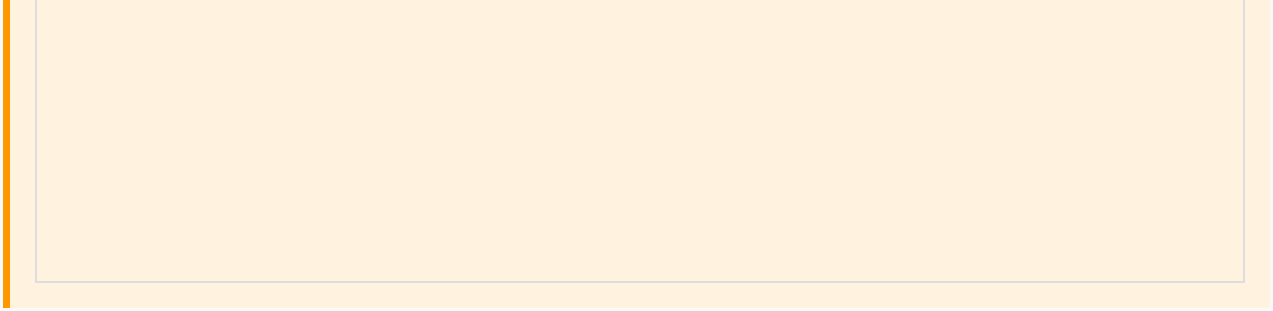

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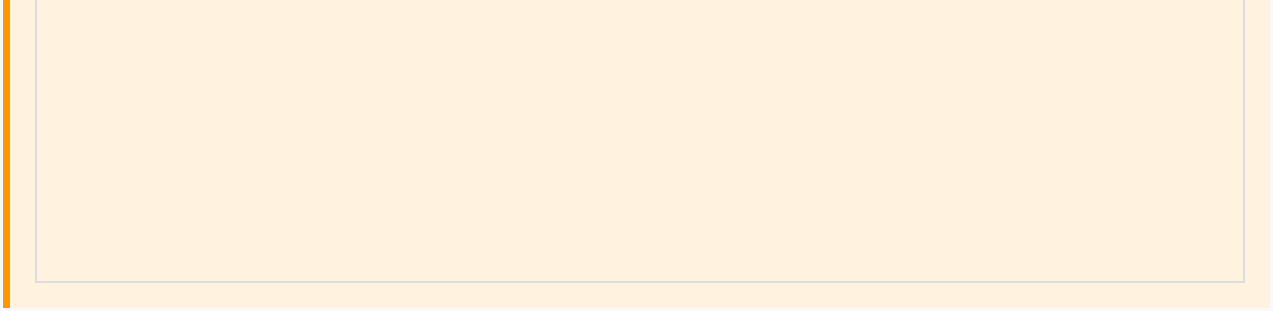
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
