#### Implementation Guidelines

Time allocation: 15 minutes for multiple choice questions, 15 minutes for short answer questions, and 15 minutes for project-based question

Administration tips: Ensure students have a clear understanding of the assessment instructions and questions, provide students with a copy of the marking guide and rubrics, and allow students to ask questions and seek clarification before starting the assessment.

#### **Differentiation Options**

For students with learning difficulties: provide extra time to complete the assessment, offer one-on-one support during the assessment, and provide a reader or scribe to assist with the assessment.

For English language learners: provide a bilingual dictionary or glossary, offer one-on-one support during the assessment, and provide a graphic organizer to help with organization and coherence.

For gifted and talented students: provide additional challenges or extensions to the assessment questions, offer the opportunity to complete a more complex project-based question, and provide feedback and guidance on how to improve their work.

## Teaching Tips

Provide explicit instruction on the concept of work immersion and its importance.

Encourage students to reflect on their personal strengths and interests and how they relate to their career goals.

Provide opportunities for students to practice and apply their skills and knowledge in a professional work environment.

Offer feedback and guidance on how to improve their work and prepare for the assessment.
