Create your own Ancient Egyptian artifact using the materials provided.

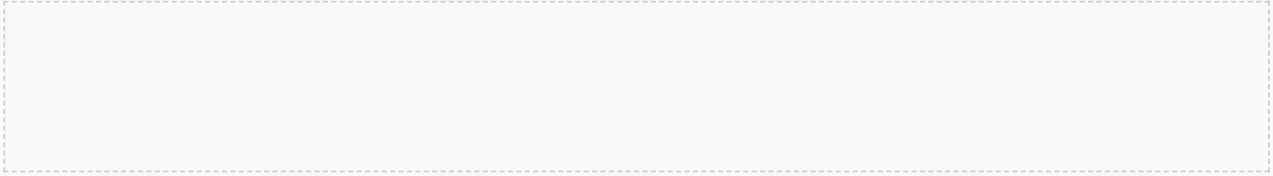
What type of artifact did you create? (e.g. jewelry, pottery, etc.)

Can you write a short message in hieroglyphics? Use the hieroglyphic alphabet provided to help you.

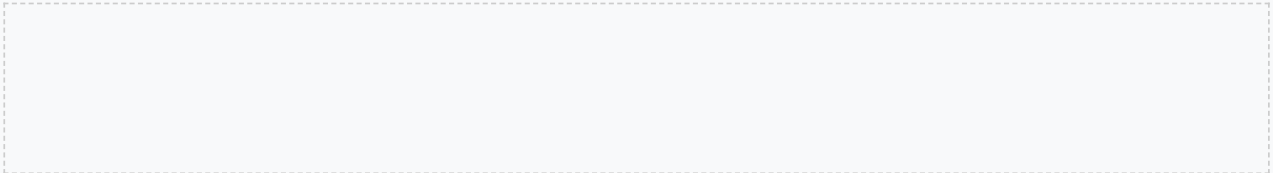


Ancient Egyptian Daily Life

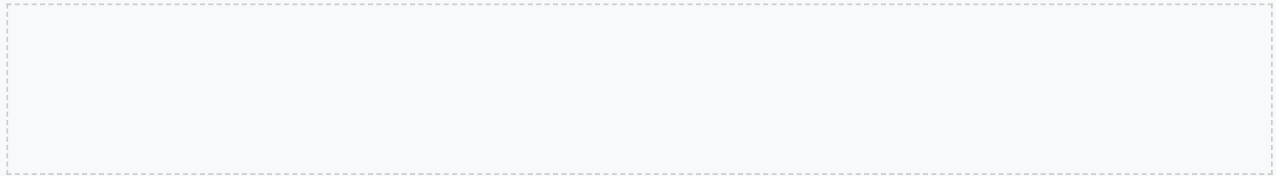


Ancient Egyptian Fun Facts
