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**Question 3**

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**Question 4**

What are the different techniques of program evaluation? Provide an example of how each technique can be used in practice.

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**Essay Question**

Discuss the role of empowerment theory in social services planning, and provide examples of how it can be applied in practice to promote community development and social change.



**Project-Based Question**

**[20 marks]**

Design a social services plan for a specific community or population, including a detailed description of the program, its goals, and objectives, and a plan for evaluation and sustainability.

## Marking Guide

The marking guide will assess your work based on the following criteria:

- Analysis and Critical Thinking: Ability to analyze community needs, design social services plans, and evaluate program effectiveness (40 points)
- Knowledge and Understanding: Demonstration of knowledge and understanding of theoretical frameworks, cultural competence, community needs assessment methods, and program evaluation techniques (30 points)
- Application and Practice: Ability to apply theoretical frameworks to practice in social services planning (20 points)
- Communication and Presentation: Clarity, coherence, and organization of written work (10 points)

The assessment will be administered in a 120-minute session, with the following time allocation:

- Case study: 40 minutes
- Short answer questions: 30 minutes
- Essay question: 40 minutes
- Project-based question: 20 minutes



## Differentiation Options

To accommodate diverse learners, the following differentiation options will be available:

- **Extended Time:** Students with disabilities or language barriers may be eligible for extended time to complete the assessment.
