- t: pronounced as "teh"
- u: pronounced as "oo"
- v: pronounced as "beh"
- w: pronounced as "doble u"
- x: pronounced as "eh-kees"
- y: pronounced as "ee-gree-eh-gah"
- z: pronounced as "zeh-tah"
