Analyzing Plot and Setting (20 minutes)

Read the following passage and analyze the plot and setting:

"As I walked through the forest, I stumbled upon a hidden clearing. The trees towered above me, and the sound of a stream filled the air. I felt a sense of peace wash over me, and I knew I had found a special place."

1. How does the setting contribute to the mood of the passage?

2. What role does the plot play in creating the mood?

3. How do the plot and setting work together to create a sense of atmosphere?

3. Share your story with the class. _____


Literary Element Map (20 minutes)

3. Share your map with the class. _____




Reflection (10 minutes)
