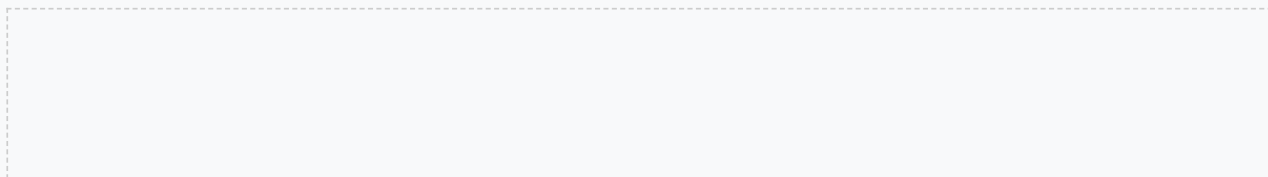

Complete the following activities:

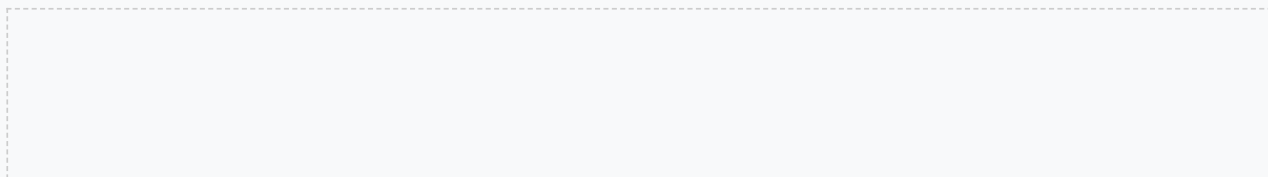
1. Draw a picture of a recyclable material and write a short sentence about why it's important to recycle it
