- Accuracy (40%): Students' ability to identify correct grammar rules, recognize vocabulary, and demonstrate reading comprehension skills.
- Completeness (30%): Students' ability to write complete sentences and paragraphs.
- Coherence (30%): Students' ability to write clear and coherent paragraphs.

The assessment will be graded based on the following rubric:

- Multiple Choice: 1 point for each correct answer
- Short Answer: 2 points for each complete and accurate answer
- Essay: 10 points for a clear and coherent paragraph, 5 points for a partially complete paragraph, 0 points for an incomplete paragraph
