Introduction to Story Settings


A story setting is the time and place in which a story takes place. It can be a real or imaginary world, and it helps to create the mood and atmosphere of the story.

Choose one of your brainstormed settings and write a short paragraph (5-7 sentences) describing it. Be sure to include:


- Time period (e.g., past, present, future)
