- Ask students to take notes and ask questions

### ● **Timeline Creation (20 mins)**

- Ask students to create a timeline of major events in the Ottoman Empire's decline and modernization
- Provide a template and examples for students to use

### ● **Closure (10 mins)**

- Summarize key points and takeaways from the lesson
- Ask students to reflect on their learning and what they would like to learn more about
