Explore how the Romans interacted with different cultures!

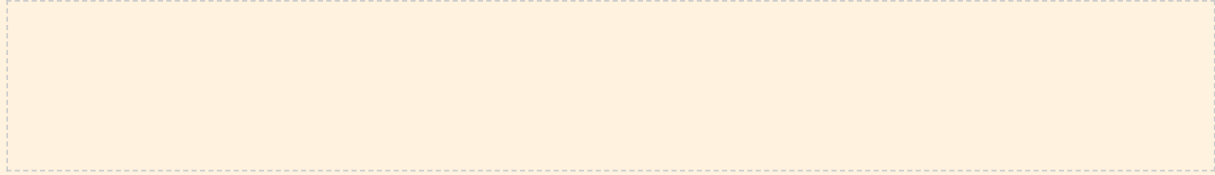
### Activity 6: Cultural Connections Map
