

Introduction

The present continuous tense is a fundamental aspect of English grammar that is used to describe actions that are currently in progress. In this worksheet, you will learn how to form and use the present continuous tense correctly.

Formation of the Present Continuous Tense

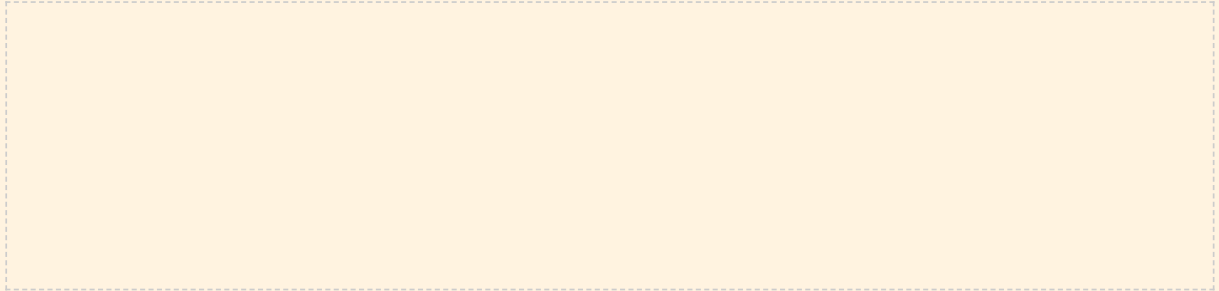
