Lesson Introduction

- · Facilitate deeper textual understanding



Implementation and Assessment

Lesson Implementation Steps

1. Text Selection (10 mins)

2. Group Arrangement (5 mins)

Organize students into small, skill-level appropriate groups.

3. Instructional Strategy (35 mins)
