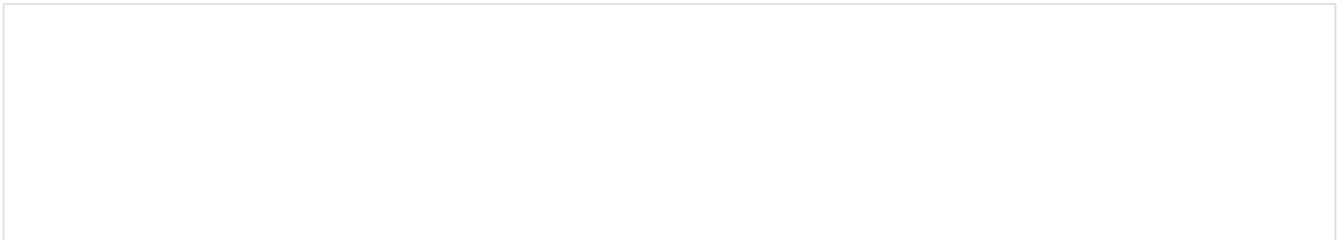
Nursery Rhyme Matching

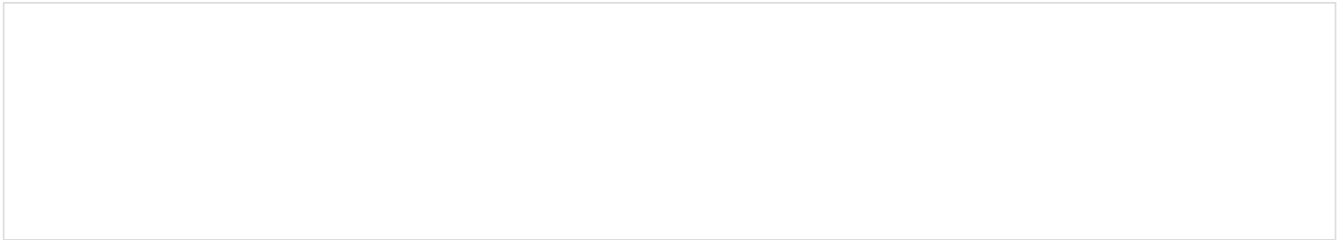

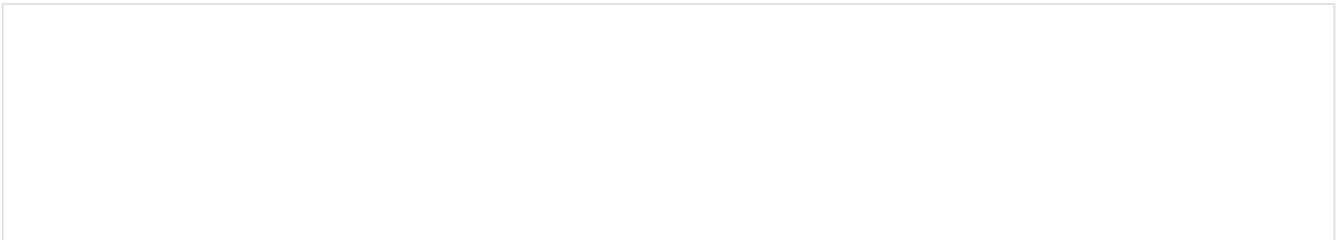

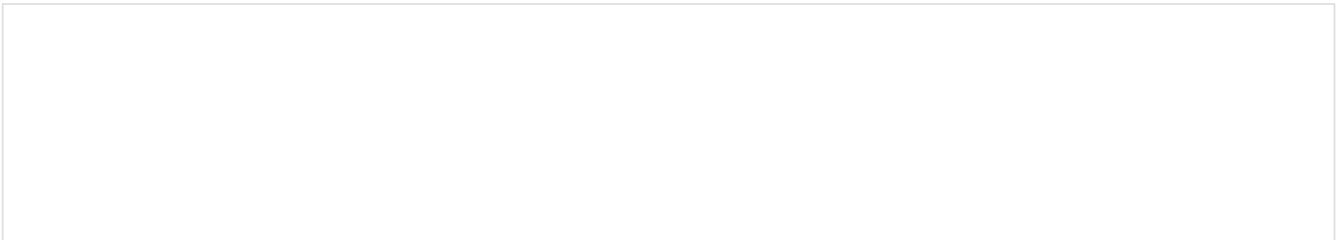
