
1. What were the main causes of World War 2, and how did they contribute to the outbreak of war?

Create a timeline of the major events of World War 2, including the invasion of Poland, the Battle of Britain, and the D-Day landings. Use the following dates as a guide:


- 1939: Invasion of Poland

Choose one of the following topics and debate it with a partner:


1. Was the use of atomic bombs in World War 2 justified?
