Introduction to Nouns and Verbs

What is a Noun?

A noun is a word that refers to a person, place, thing, or idea. Examples of nouns include:

- Book
- Chair
- Dog
- City

What is a Verb?

A verb is a word that shows action or movement. Examples of verbs include:

- Run
- Jump
- Read
- Write
