## Introduction to Nouns and Verbs (Page 1)

What is a noun? A noun is a word that refers to a person, place, thing, or idea.

What is a verb? A verb is a word that shows action or movement.

### Examples:

Nouns: book, chair, dogVerbs: run, jump, read
