



Introduction to Nouns and Verbs (Page 1)

What is a noun? A noun is a word that refers to a person, place, thing, or idea.

What is a verb? A verb is a word that shows action or movement.

Examples:

- Nouns: book, chair, dog
- Verbs: run, jump, read

Activity: Match the nouns and verbs with their definitions.

Word	Definition
Book	A person
Run	A thing
Chair	An action
Dog	A place
Jump	An idea

Identifying Nouns and Verbs (Page 2)

Identify the nouns and verbs in the following sentences:

1. The dog runs quickly. (Noun: dog, Verb: runs)
2. The teacher writes on the board. (Noun: teacher, Verb: writes)
3. The sun shines brightly. (Noun: sun, Verb: shines)

Creating Simple Sentences (Page 3)

Examples:

- I read a book.
- The dog runs quickly.
- She sits on a chair.

Examples:

- The dog runs quickly.
- I read a book.
- She sits on a chair.

- Noun: pencil, Verb: write
- Noun: bike, Verb: ride
- Noun: park, Verb: play
