Introduction

Welcome to our "Greetings Around the World" homework sheet! In this activity, you will embark on a linguistic journey to explore how to say "hello" in different languages and contexts. This activity is designed to support your learning objectives of recognizing and repeating basic greetings in English and other languages.

Page 1: Fun with Greetings!

Listen and Repeat: Listen to the audio clips or videos of people saying "hello" in different languages.
Copy the Greeting : Repeat the greeting you heard, trying to imitate the pronunciation as closely as possible.
Match the Greeting: Match the greeting with the correct language and country.

Language Exploration Stations

Station 1: English Hello
Listen to a native English speaker say "hello" and repeat it.

Station 2: Spanish Hola
Listen to a native Spanish speaker say "hola" and repeat it.

Learn a simple sentence using "nǐ hǎo" (e.g., "nǐ hǎo, wǒ jiào").

 Write a simple sentence using the greeting 	

Page 4: Create Your Own Greeting Card Draw a picture of yourself saying "hello" in your favorite language and write the greeting underneath.

Choose a language not covered in the main activities and research how to say "hello" in that language. Write the greeting and a simple sentence using the greeting.

Page 5: Research a New Language

Page 6-7: Greeting Card Exchange

Create greeting cards with "hello" in different languages and exchange them with classmates or family members. Write a short message in the language you are learning.
