2. How will this learning change your actions in the future?

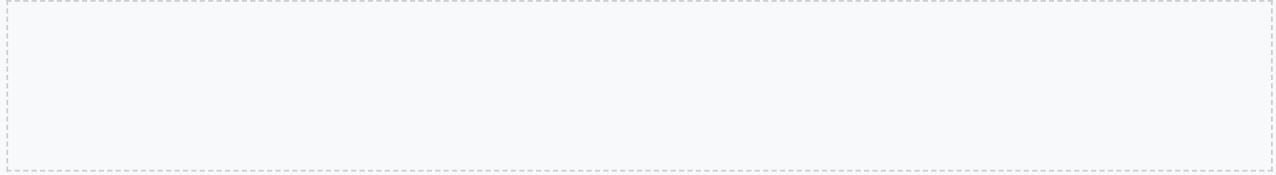
3. What questions do you still have about narrative summaries and visual representations?
