



## Introduction (Page 1 of 10)

---

*Welcome to this worksheet on analyzing moral dilemmas through real-life scenarios with visual aids and graphic organizers. This activity is designed for 12-year-old students to develop critical thinking and ethical decision-making skills.*

A moral dilemma is a situation where you have to make a difficult choice between two or more options, neither of which is clearly right or wrong. Consider the following scenario:

Your friend asks you to keep a secret, but you know that keeping the secret could harm someone else.

1. What is a moral dilemma?

2. Can you think of a time when you faced a moral dilemma? What did you do?

1. A company is deciding whether to prioritize profits or environmental concerns.

2. A student is considering whether to cheat on a test to get a good grade.

*What are the ethical considerations in each scenario? How would you approach each situation?*

*For ELL/ESL students, use the following visual vocabulary to help you understand the scenarios:*

- **Moral dilemma:** a difficult choice between two or more options
- **Ethics:** the study of what is right and wrong
- **Consequence:** the result of a particular action or decision

## Group Activity (Page 5 of 10)

### **Group Task:**

Work in groups to analyze the following scenario:

A friend is being bullied at school. What do you do?

*Use a graphic organizer to analyze the situation. Discuss the pros and cons of each option. Present your findings to the class.*
