Introduction (Page 1 of 10)
Welcome to this worksheet on analyzing moral dilemmas through real-life scenarios with visual aids and graphic organizers. This activity is designed for 12-year-old students to develop critical thinking and ethical decision-making skills.
A moral dilemma is a situation where you have to make a difficult choice between two or more options, neither of which is clearly right or wrong. Consider the following scenario:
