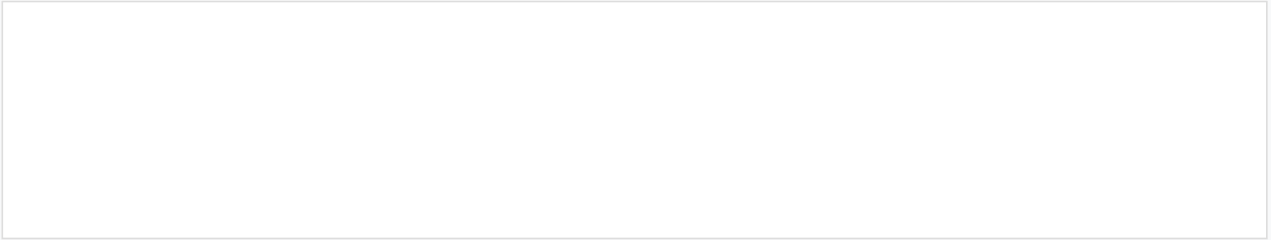

Introduction to Nursery Rhymes and Storytelling

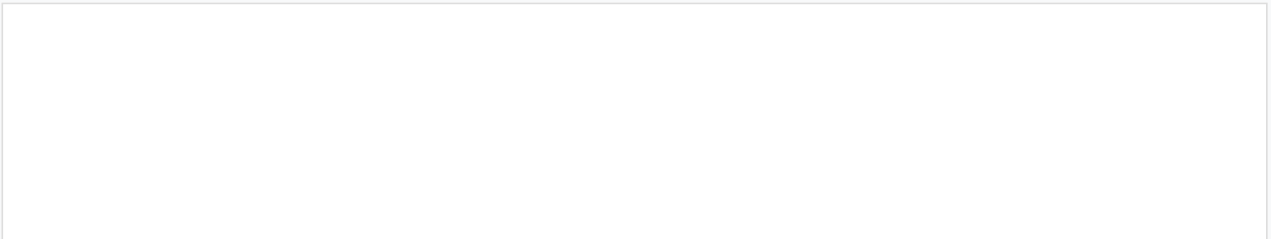

Draw a picture of the star and write the first line of the rhyme: "Twinkle, twinkle, little star"



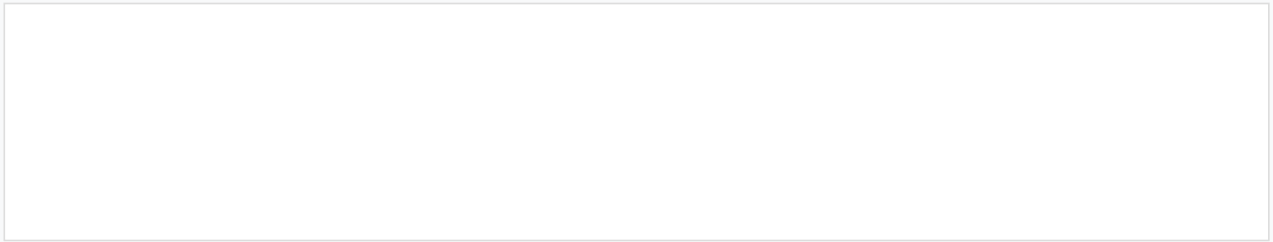
Can you think of another nursery rhyme that has a similar theme? Write the title of the rhyme and draw a picture to illustrate it.



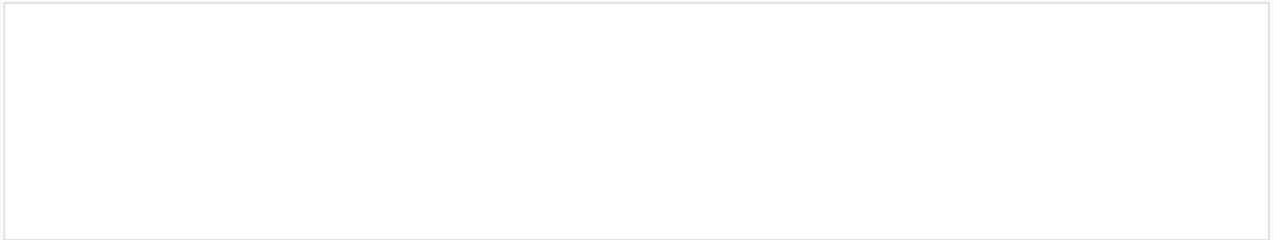
Read the following story: "Goldilocks and the Three Bears"

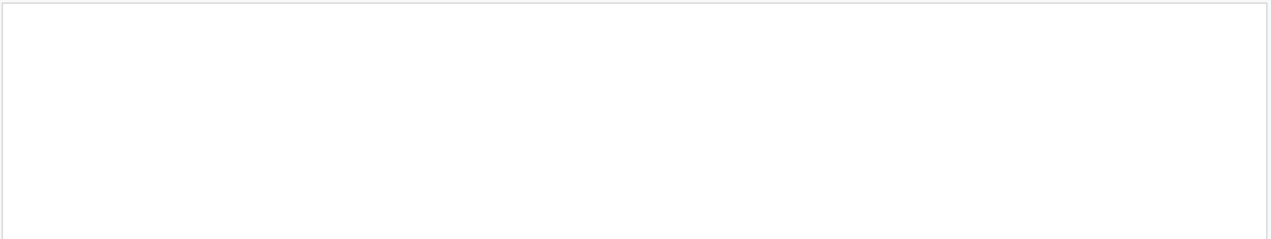

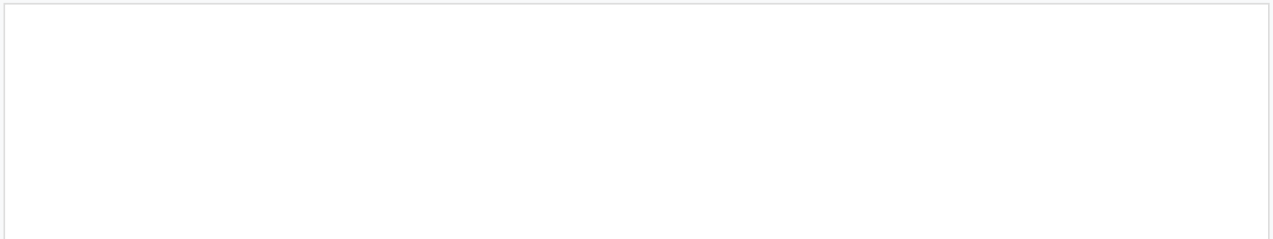
