Centers are special areas in the classroom where we can learn and play. We can choose which center we want to go to and what activity we want to do.


What center do you want to go to first? Why?

Conclusion (10 minutes)


In conclusion, classroom centers and outdoor play areas are fun and important places where we can learn and play. We can use guided discovery and craft activities to learn new things and make new friends.

Activities and Questions


1. Draw a picture of your favorite classroom center. What activities do you like to do there?




2. Write a story about a time when you went to an outdoor play area. What did you do? Who did you play with?




3. Make a craft project using recycled materials. What did you make? Why did you choose those materials?
