Create a basic plan for how to use technology to improve productivity.

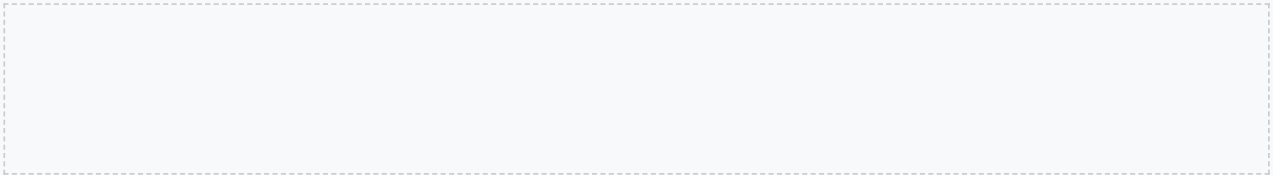
Develop a detailed plan, including specific strategies for staying focused and avoiding distractions.
