Introduction

This worksheet aims to reinforce your understanding of nouns and verbs, and how they function in sentences. By completing the activities in this worksheet, you will be able to distinguish between nouns and verbs, provide examples of each, and demonstrate an understanding of their roles in sentence construction.

Write three complete sentences using each noun with a different verb.

Part B: Create your own set of 3 nouns and 3 verbs

Write three sentences using each noun with a different verb.

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Activity 4: Sentence Completion

Complete the following sentences with either a noun or a verb

Activity 5: Creative Writing

Write a short story (less than 1 page) using at least 5 different nouns and 5 different verbs.

Try to use a variety of sentence structures.

Activity 6: Poetry

Write a poem about your favorite season, incorporating as many nouns and verbs as possible related to that season.
