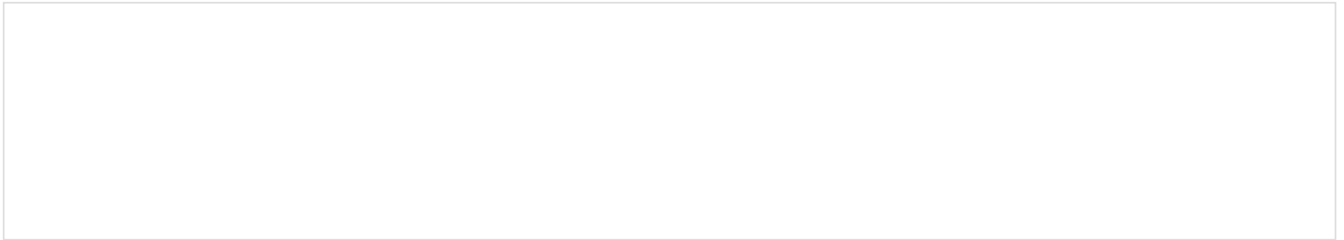
Activity 4: Creative Writing
