

Understanding Rainforest Protection

Subject Area: Environmental Science **Unit Title:** Rainforest Protection **Grade Level:** Grade 2 (7-year-olds)

Lesson Number: 1 of 3

Duration: 45 minutes **Location:** Classroom

Materials Needed: Visual aids, craft supplies

Technology: Projector for images

Learning Objectives

By the end of this lesson, students will be able to:

- Explain why rainforests are important for our planet
- · Identify three animals that live in the Amazon rainforest
- · Describe how deforestation affects wildlife
- · Suggest two ways to help protect rainforests

Key Vocabulary

- Rainforest: A forest with tall trees and lots of rain
- **Deforestation:** Cutting down many trees
- Habitat: A home for animals and plants
- Protection: Keeping something safe
- Environment: The world around us



Lesson Introduction (10 minutes)

Opening Activity:

- · Show large picture of Amazon rainforest
- · Ask students what they see in the picture
- Create a word web of student responses

Hook:

- Tell story: "A Day in the Life of a Rainforest"
- Use sound effects of rainforest animals
- · Show pictures of colorful animals and plants

Main Activities (25 minutes)

Activity 1: Rainforest Home Game

- · Students pretend to be rainforest animals
- Create paper "trees" as homes
- Demonstrate effect of deforestation

Activity 2: Tree Importance Chart

- Create class chart: "Why Trees Help Us"
- Draw pictures of tree benefits
- Discussion of findings

Differentiation Strategies

Support Strategies:

- Picture cards for vocabulary
- · Partner work for activities
- · Movement breaks between tasks

Extension Activities:

- Create rainforest fact book
- · Research specific animals
- · Design protection poster



Assessment Strategies

Formative Assessment:

- · Observation during activities
- Class discussions
- Drawing and writing tasks

Success Criteria:

- Can name 3 rainforest animals
- Explains why trees are important
- Participates in class activities
- · Shows understanding of protection concepts

Closure Activities (10 minutes)

Review Activity:

- "Tree Pledge" creation
- Share one new thing learned
- · Class discussion on helping forests

Take-Home Connection

Family Engagement:

- · Draw picture of favorite rainforest animal
- · Count trees in neighborhood
- Share "Tree Pledge" with family
