2. What psychological challenges emerge in digital interactions?

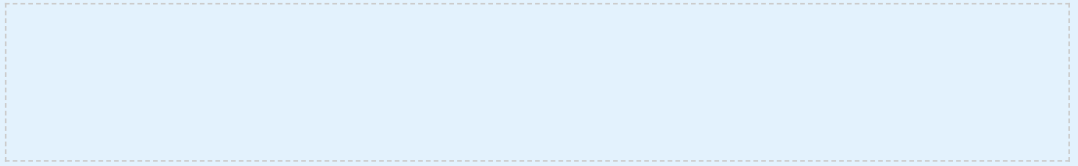

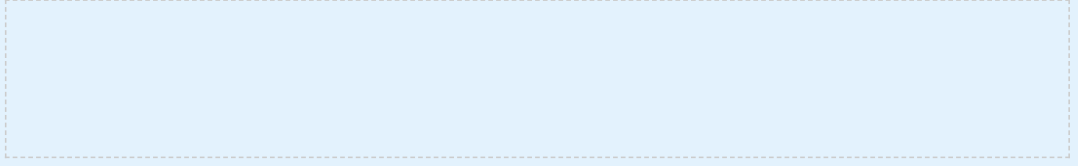
