What are Nouns?

A noun is a word that represents a person, place, thing, or idea.

Examples of nouns: dog, city, happiness

What are Verbs?

A verb is a word that represents an action or a state of being.

Examples of verbs: run, jump, read

Types of Nouns

Examples of abstract nouns: happiness, freedom
