Pre-Lesson Preparation

Room Setup:

- Arrange desks in a U-shape to facilitate group work and discussion
- · Prepare letter and number charts for display

Technology Needs:

- · Smartboard for presentations and interactive activities
- · Tablets for students to practice letter and number recognition

Materials Preparation:

- · Letter and number flashcards
- · Word cards for phonetic awareness activities

Safety Considerations:

- Ensure students are seated safely and comfortably during activities
- · Monitor students during group work to prevent distractions

Detailed Lesson Flow

Introduction (5 minutes)

- · Introduce the topic of letters and numbers
- Review the importance of letters and numbers in daily life

Letter Introduction (15 minutes)

- · Present the alphabet using flashcards and the smartboard
- · Have students repeat the names of the letters

Engagement Strategies:

- Use songs and rhymes to make learning fun and engaging
- Encourage students to share their favorite letters and why they like them

Number Introduction (15 minutes)

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- Present numbers 1-10 using flashcards and the smartboard
- · Have students count objects to practice number recognition

Checking for Understanding:

- · Use formative assessments to check students' understanding of letters and numbers
- · Provide feedback and adjust instruction as needed



Differentiation & Support Strategies

For Struggling Learners:

- Provide extra support and practice with letter and number recognition
- Use visual aids and manipulatives to help students understand concepts

For Advanced Learners:

- Provide challenging activities and games to reinforce learning
- Encourage students to create their own letter and number games

- Use visual aids and pictures to help ELL students understand vocabulary
- · Provide bilingual resources and support for ELL students

Lesson 1: Introduction to Letters

Objectives:

- Recognize and name uppercase and lowercase letters
- · Identify the sounds of letters

Materials:

- · Letter flashcards
- Alphabet chart

Procedure:

- 1. Introduce the alphabet using flashcards and the alphabet chart
- 2. Have students repeat the names of the letters
- 3. Use songs and rhymes to make learning fun and engaging

Activity 1: Letter Scavenger Hunt

Objective: Recognize and name uppercase and lowercase letters **Materials:**

- Letter flashcards
- · Scavenger hunt worksheet

- 1. Distribute the scavenger hunt worksheet to students
- 2. Hide the letter flashcards around the classroom
- 3. Have students find the letters and write them on their worksheet



Lesson 2: Introduction to Numbers

Objectives:

- Count and identify numbers 1-10
- · Recognize the relationship between numbers and quantities

Materials:

- · Number flashcards
- Number lines

Procedure:

- 1. Introduce numbers 1-10 using flashcards and number lines
- 2. Have students count objects to practice number recognition
- 3. Use real-life examples to demonstrate the relationship between numbers and quantities

Activity 2: Number Bingo

Objective: Count and identify numbers 1-10 Materials:

- · Number bingo cards
- Number caller

- 1. Distribute the bingo cards to students
- 2. Call out numbers and have students mark them on their cards
- 3. The first student to get five numbers in a row wins



Lesson 3: Association of Letters and Sounds

Objectives:

- · Associate letters with their corresponding sounds
- Recognize the relationship between letters and sounds

Materials:

- · Letter and sound flashcards
- Word cards

Procedure:

- 1. Introduce the association of letters and sounds using flashcards and word cards
- 2. Have students practice reading words and identifying the sounds of letters
- 3. Use games and activities to reinforce the association of letters and sounds

Activity 3: Word Building

Objective: Associate letters with their corresponding sounds Materials:

- Letter tiles
- · Word cards

- 1. Distribute the letter tiles and word cards to students
- 2. Have students build words using the letter tiles
- 3. Have students read the words and identify the sounds of the letters



Lesson 4: Practice of Reading and Writing

Objectives:

- · Practice reading and writing words
- · Recognize the relationship between letters and sounds in words

Materials:

- · Word cards
- · Writing paper

Procedure:

- 1. Have students practice reading words using the word cards
- 2. Have students write words using the writing paper
- 3. Use games and activities to reinforce the practice of reading and writing

Activity 4: Reading and Writing Center

Objective: Practice reading and writing words Materials:

- Word cards
- Writing paper
- · Pencils and pens

- 1. Set up a reading and writing center in the classroom
- 2. Have students rotate through the center and practice reading and writing words
- 3. Provide feedback and support to students as needed
