Detailed Lesson Flow

Introduction (10 minutes)

- · Introduce the topic of employability and career development

Key Skills and Qualities (20 minutes)

- Presentation on key skills and qualities required for future employment
- Use real-life examples and case studies to illustrate their importance

Engagement Strategies:

What is Employability?

Employability refers to the skills, qualities, and knowledge that make an individual capable of securing and maintaining employment

It involves the ability to adapt to changing work environments, learn new skills, and demonstrate a positive attitude towards work

Key Skills and Qualities

Communication Skills:

- · Verbal and non-verbal communication
- · Active listening and clarification

Teamwork Skills:

- · Collaboration and cooperation
- Conflict resolution and negotiation

Problem-Solving Skills:

- · Analysis and critical thinking
- Creativity and innovation

Importance of Employability

What is Career Development?

Career development refers to the process of planning, implementing, and managing one's career

It involves setting career goals, identifying skills and knowledge gaps, and developing strategies to achieve career aspirations

Career Development Process

Self-Assessment:

- · Identify strengths, weaknesses, and interests
- · Explore career options and opportunities

Career Exploration:

- Research career paths and job requirements
- · Network with professionals and seek advice

Career Planning:

- · Set career goals and objectives
- · Develop a career action plan
