



Introduction (10 minutes)

Welcome to this worksheet on analyzing the impact of globalization on personal identity through multimedia representation. Read the introduction and answer the following questions:

1. What is the main theme of this worksheet?

2. What is the title of the TED Talk that will be used in this activity?

3. What skills will you apply in this activity?

Understanding the TED Talk (20 minutes)

Watch the TED Talk "Where is Home" by Pico Iyer and take notes on the key themes and ideas presented. Answer the following questions:

1. What is the main theme of the TED Talk?

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2. How does Pico Iyer define the concept of "home"?

3. What are some of the challenges and opportunities of navigating multiple cultural identities in a globalized world?

Reflecting on Personal Identity (20 minutes)

Reflect on your own personal identity and sense of belonging. Answer the following questions:

1. How do you define yourself?

2. What are some of the factors that shape your personal identity (e.g. culture, family, community)?

3. How do you think globalization has impacted your personal identity?

Creating a Multimedia Representation (30 minutes)

Choose a multimedia format (e.g. video, podcast, infographic) to represent your understanding of the TED Talk. Create a multimedia representation that explores the theme of globalization and personal identity.

Group Task:

Include images, music, and other creative elements to enhance your representation.

Analyzing the Impact of Globalization (25 minutes)

Research and analyze the impact of globalization on personal identity. Answer the following questions:

1. What are some of the positive and negative effects of globalization on personal identity?

2. How can individuals navigate multiple cultural identities in a globalized world?

3. What are some strategies for promoting cultural understanding and global citizenship?

Presenting Your Findings (20 minutes)

Present your multimedia representation to the class. Discuss your findings on the impact of globalization on personal identity.

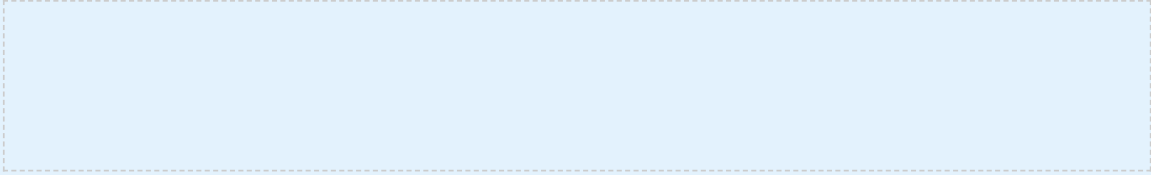
Individual Reflection:

Assessment Rubric

Use the following rubric to assess your multimedia representation:

- Content (40%): Does the multimedia representation demonstrate a clear understanding of the theme of globalization and personal identity?
- Creativity and Originality (30%): Does the multimedia representation demonstrate creative and original thinking?
- Technical Skills (20%): Does the multimedia representation demonstrate proficiency in the use of multimedia and ICT skills?
- Presentation and Communication (10%): Is the presentation clear, concise, and effective in communicating the findings?

Extension Activity

Create a documentary film that explores the impact of globalization on personal identity in your local community.

Group Task:

Include interviews with community members, footage of cultural events, and analysis of the impact of globalization on personal identity.

Glossary

Define the following terms:

- Globalization: The process of increasing global interconnectedness, characterized by the free flow of goods, services, and ideas across national borders.
- Personal Identity: An individual's sense of self, shaped by their experiences, culture, and relationships.
- Cultural Identity: The aspects of a person's identity that are shaped by their cultural heritage and traditions.
- Multimedia: The use of multiple forms of media, such as text, images, audio, and video, to communicate information and ideas.
