
### Introduction


## Activity 1: Word Identification

Read the sentences carefully and circle each word:


1. The sun is shining brightly.

1. The baby laughed at the clown.

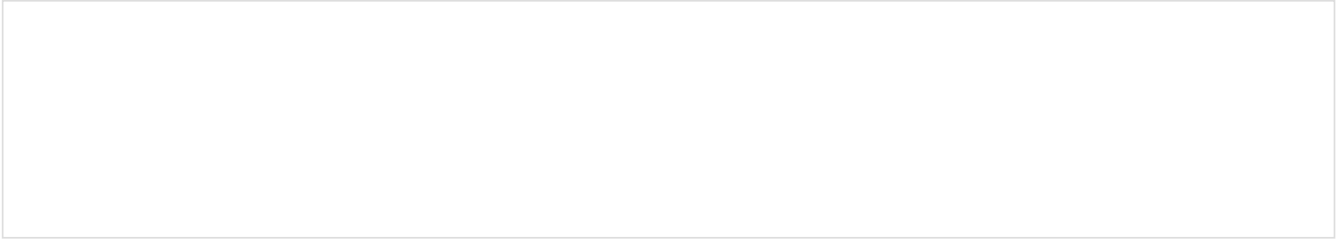
2. Flowers are beautiful and colorful.
