
What are Character Traits?

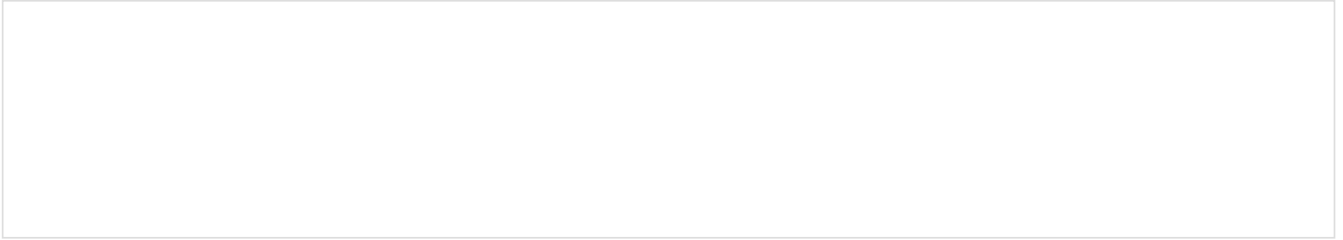
