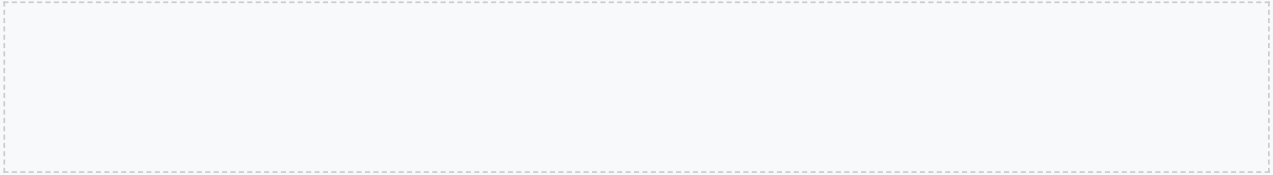

In Pakistan, children wake up early in the morning for prayer and breakfast. They then attend school, where they learn about Islamic studies, mathematics, and language.

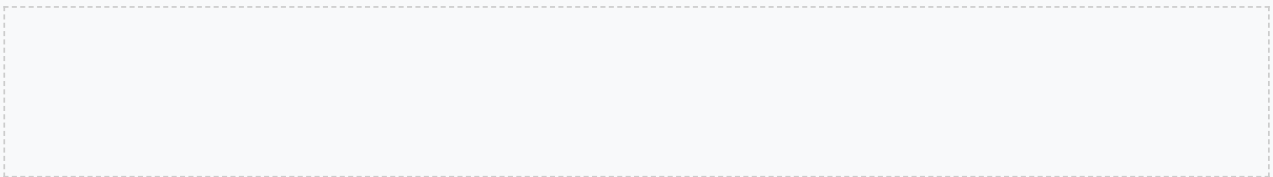

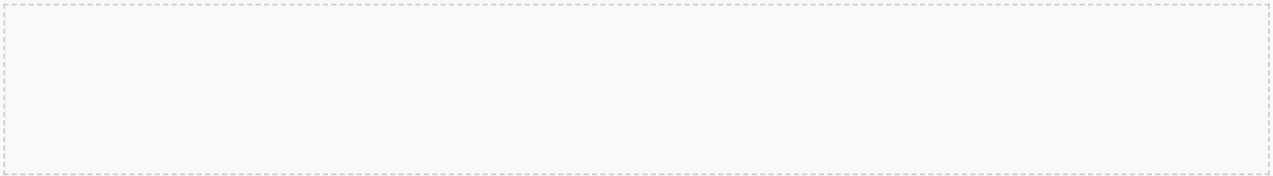

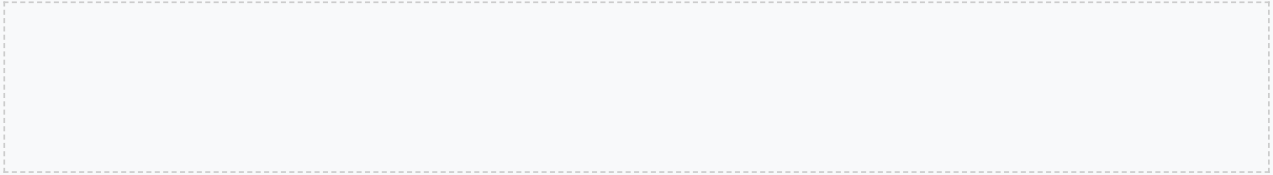

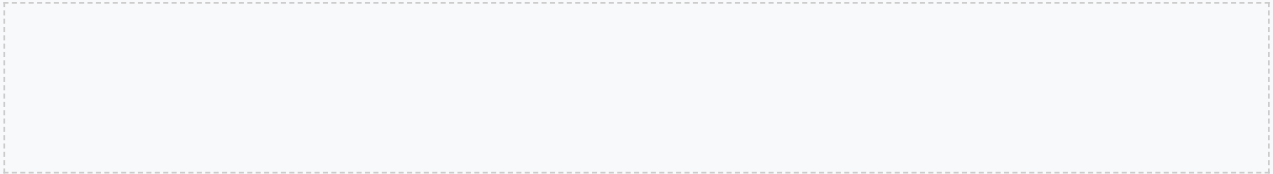

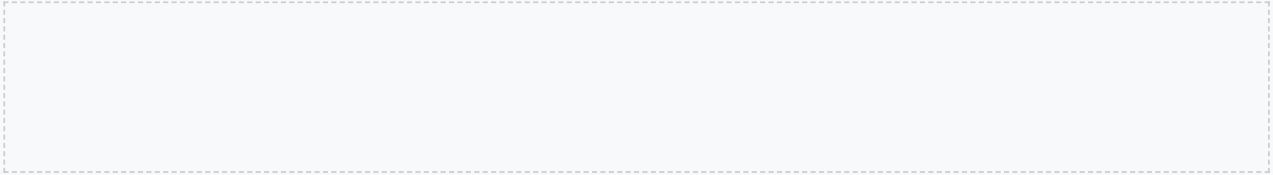


Cultural Traditions

In Pakistan, children celebrate Eid-al-Fitr and Eid-al-Azha, while in London, children celebrate Christmas and Halloween.

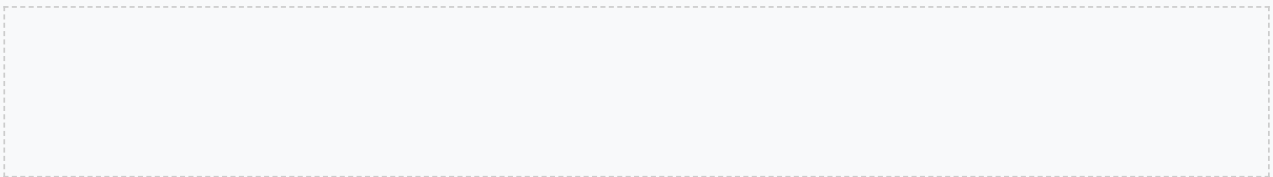
