Punctuation marks are the secret code that helps us communicate clearly in writing! They guide readers through our thoughts, showing where to pause, stop, or get excited.

Common Punctuation Marks
Basic Level

Period: Signals the end of a complete thought

Example: I love learning about punctuation.

, Comma: Separates items or creates a pause

Example: I need milk, bread, eggs, and cheese.

? Question Mark: Shows a direct question

Example: Have you ever seen a shooting star?
