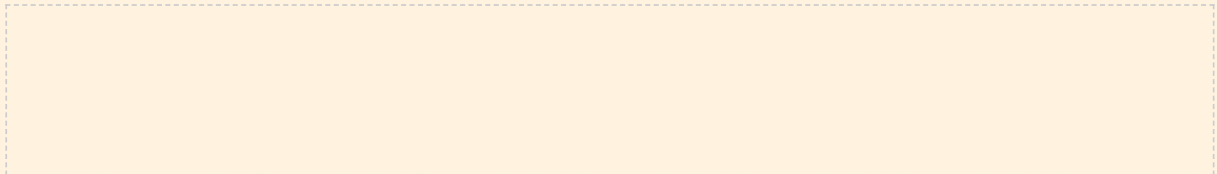

- Manner: e.g., quickly, loudly, wisely


