


## Page 1: My Self-Portrait

**What are you wearing in your picture?**




Ask a grown-up to help you write your name on the picture. Try to write your name all by yourself, but it's okay if you need a little help.

**Can you write your name on your own?**




Draw pictures of your friends in the classroom. You can include your teacher and any other friends you like to play with.

**Who is your best friend in the classroom?**

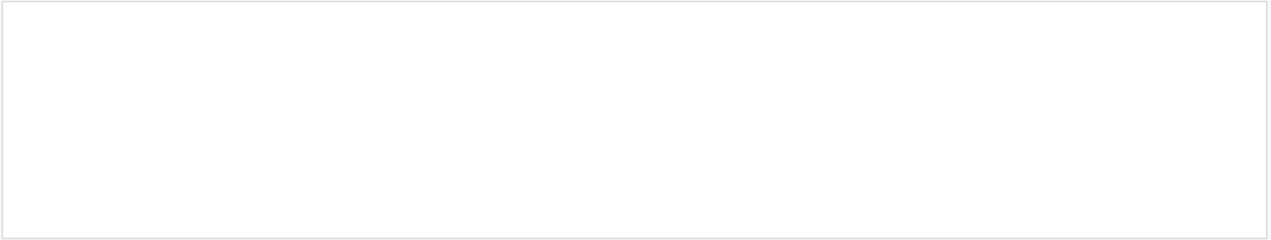


**What do you like to play with your friends?**




Draw or write about your favorite things in the classroom, such as blocks, toys, or books.


**What is your favorite toy in the classroom?**



**Why do you like it?**

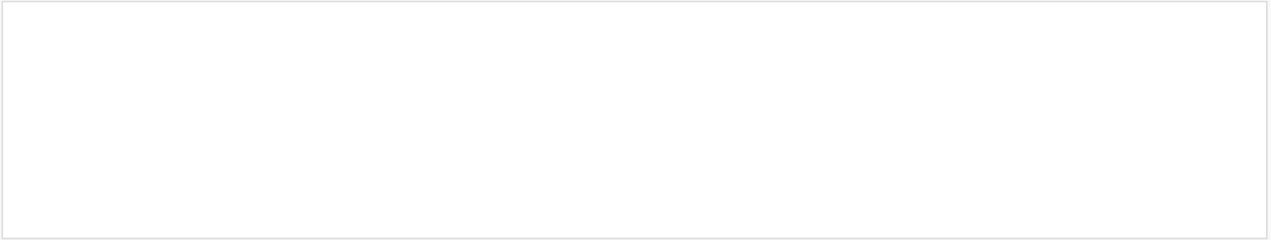


Use the following worksheet to practice tracing your name. Start with big letters and then try smaller ones.

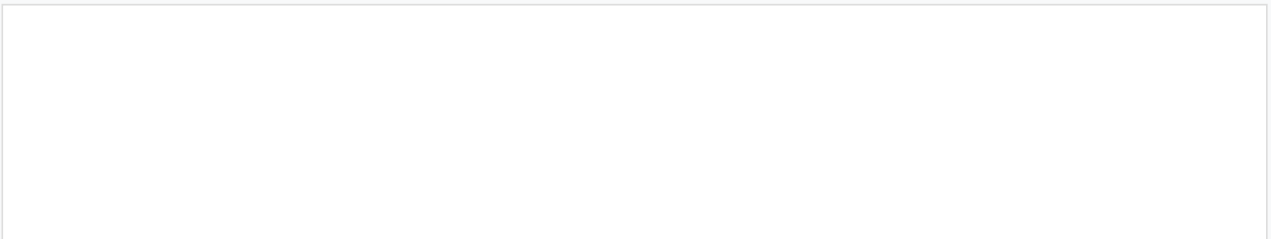

**Who is in your picture?**




Cut out paper shapes and write the names of your friends on each one. Connect the shapes to create a friendship chain.

**What do you like about your friends?**




Draw different emotion faces (happy, sad, angry, surprised) and write a sentence about how you feel when you're in each of those emotions.
