Activity 3: Story Creation

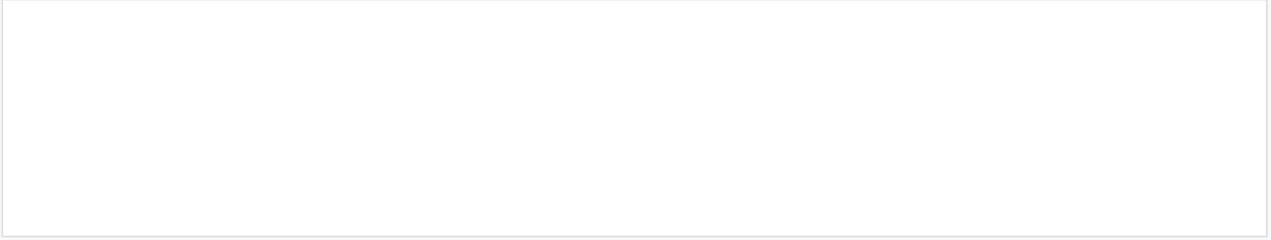
Create a short story that conveys a key element of proper behavior, such as sharing or empathy.
