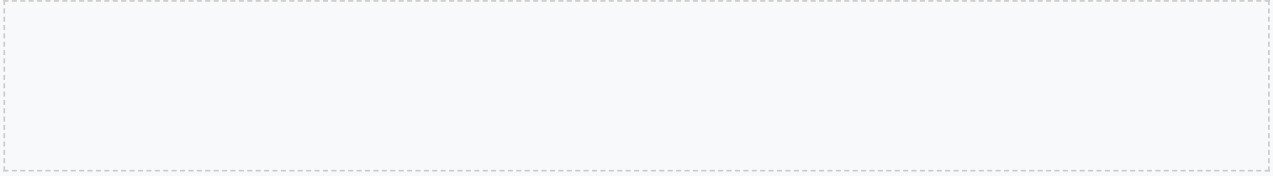

Activity 3: Adding Multimedia Elements (25 minutes)


Add the following multimedia elements to your story:

3. An animation to bring the characters to life




Activity 4: Presenting Your Story (20 minutes)

Present your short story to the class. Use the multimedia presentation software to showcase your work and engage your audience.






