A farmer has 15 chickens and 8 ducks on the farm. If 3 chickens and 2 ducks are sold, how many birds are left on the farm? What is the ratio of chickens to ducks?

2. A farmer is responsible for planting, harvesting, and caring for crops and animals on a farm.
