Introduction to the Future Simple Tense

The Future Simple tense is a fundamental concept in English grammar that enables students to express actions that will occur in the future. In this worksheet, we will explore the formation and usage of the Future Simple tense, and practice using it in various contexts.

Formation of the Future Simple Tense	
The Future Simple tense is formed using the auxiliary verb "will" or "shall" followed by the base form of the main verb. For example: "I will go to the park tomorrow" or "She will study for her exam tonight."	
 I (go) to the store tomorrow. They (not/be) at home next week. We (have) a test on Friday. 	

Usage of the Future Simple Tense
The Future Simple tense is used to express actions that will occur in the future, such as making plans, predictions, and talking about future events. For example: "I will attend the school play next week" or "It will rain tomorrow, so don't forget your umbrella."
 By next year, I (finish) my homework. If I won the lottery, I (travel) around the world. They (not/come) to the party if it's raining.
