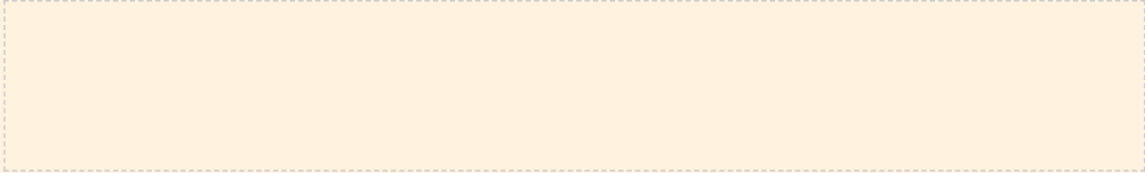
1. Draw a picture that represents your thoughts and feelings about migration
