4. What is the rhythm of ocean waves?

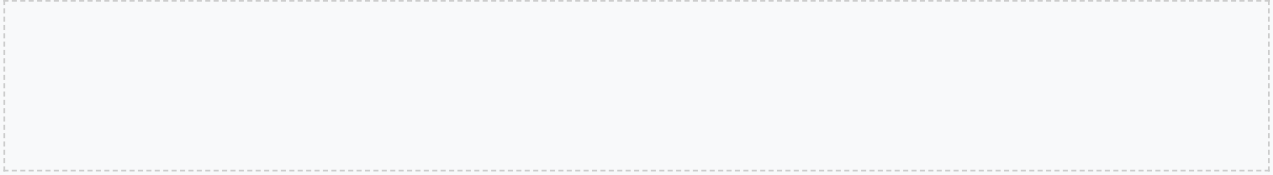
5. What is the tempo of a dog barking?

Answer the following questions:


1. Can you name three natural sounds?
