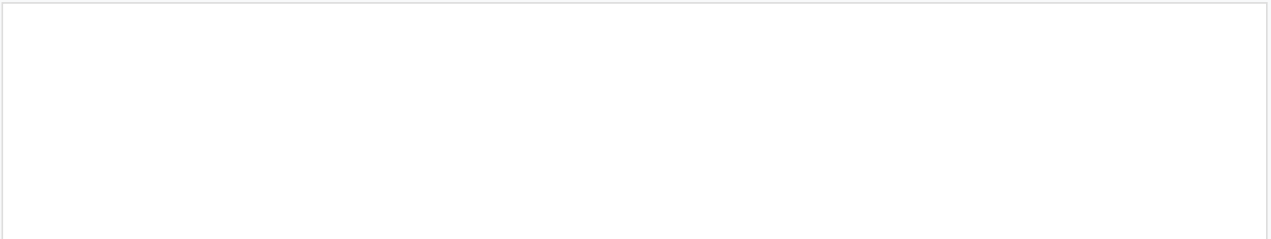
Debate
