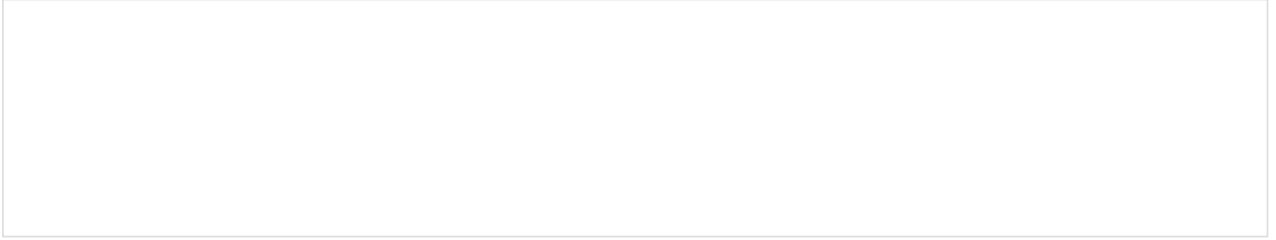

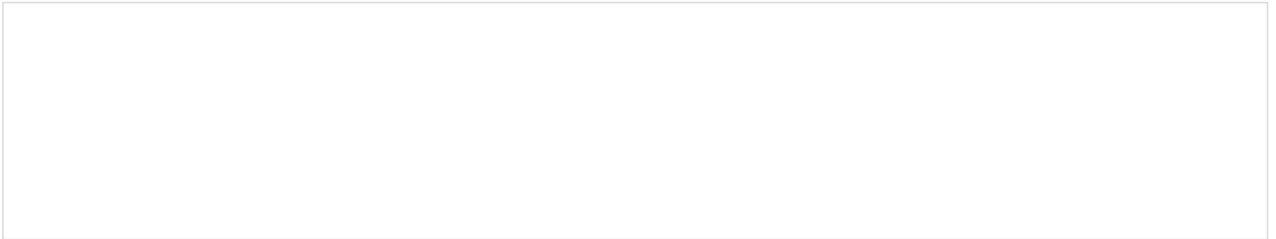

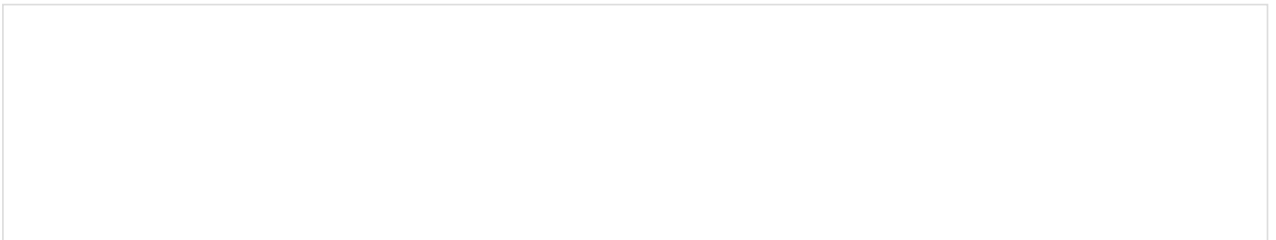

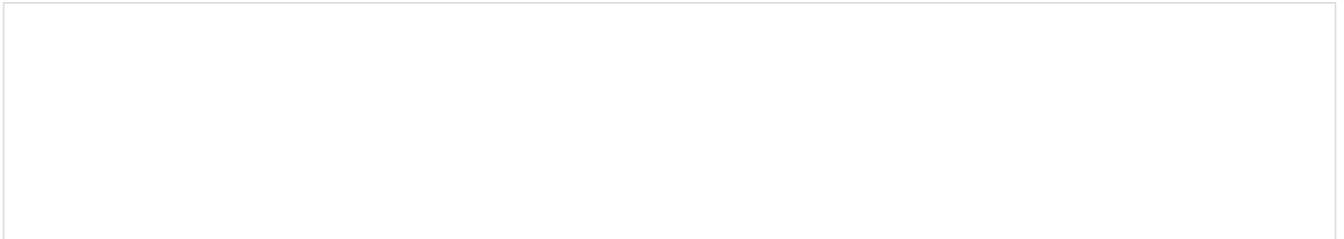
Storytelling
