



Introduction

This diagnostic assessment is designed to evaluate students' understanding of gerunds with like, love, and enjoy in job descriptions. The assessment aims to identify students' ability to identify and explain the correct usage of gerunds in sentences related to job descriptions, demonstrate understanding of verb forms and sentence structure, and apply gerund phrases to express preferences and interests in job-related contexts.
