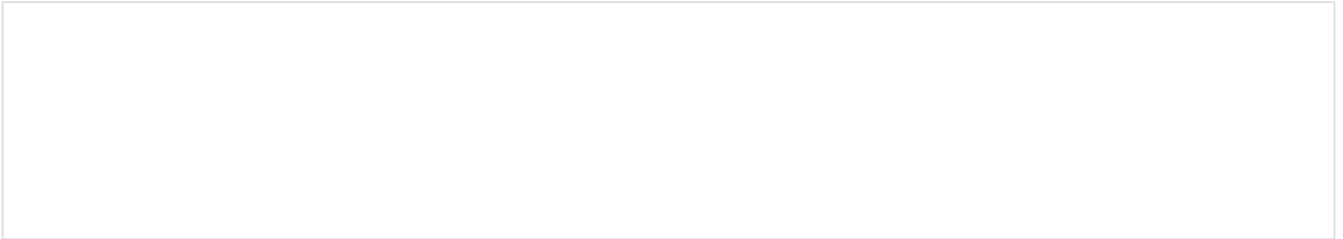
## Introduction

Practice building your own sentences using date-related vocabulary in Spanish.

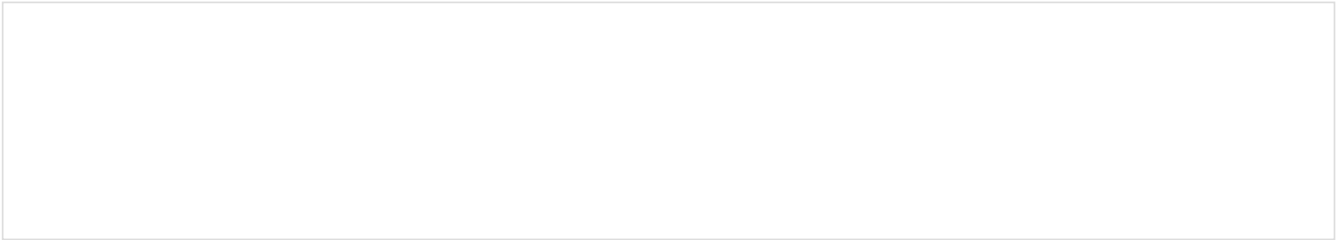

Color the picture of a calendar and practice saying the days of the week and months of the year in Spanish.

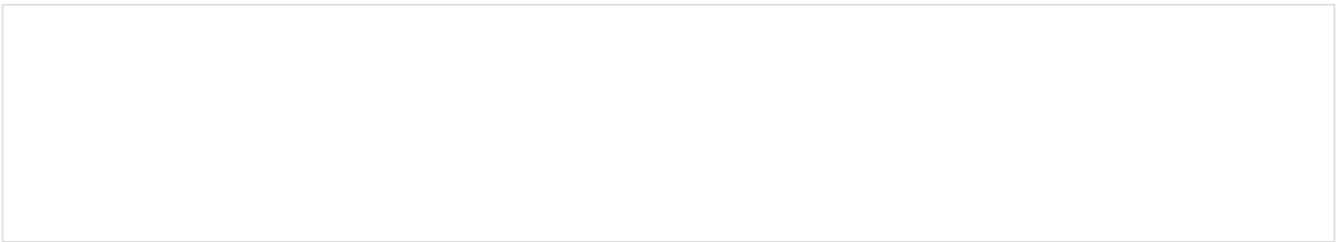
