What is Guided Reading?

Guided reading is a targeted instructional approach where teachers work with small groups of students at similar reading levels to develop comprehensive reading skills.

Key Reading Strategies

1. Predicting

Before reading, make predictions about the text based on title, images, or prior knowledge.

Example:

Look at a book's cover and predict what the story might be about.

2. Questioning

Generate questions before, during, and after reading to enhance comprehension.

Example:

Ask: "What might happen next?" or "Why did the character make that choice?"
